Dear All,

the year 2022 marks the 50th anniversary of the establishment of Poland's first Faculty of Music Therapy at the State University School of Music (PWSM) renamed the Karol Lipiński Academy of Music in Wrocław (AMKL) in 1981. On this occasion, as the members of the Faculty of Music Therapy at the Karol Lipiński Academy of Music in Wrocław, we would like to kindly invite you to participate in the 2nd European Forum of Music Therapists “Music Therapy in Rehumanisation of Contemporary Life”. The subject matter of the conference will refer to the still up-to-date thought of Professor Tadeusz Natanson included in the Polish scientific conception of music therapy. The conference will be a continuation of the cycle of international scientific conferences organised by the Faculty of Music Therapy at PWSM and AMKL known as the “All-Polish Meetings of Colleagues of the Faculty of Music Therapy” (since 1973) and then as the “Forum of Music Therapists” (since 2003). We would like to mention that the first European Forum of Music Therapists took place under the “European Capital of Culture Wrocław 2016” and attracted great interest among the representatives of the world of music and culture, practitioners and theoreticians of music therapy, specialists in related fields and the media.

The goal of the 2nd European Forum of Music Therapists will be to exchange music therapy knowledge and practice, inspire to establish co-operation and form new interdisciplinary research teams, integrate scientific and teaching employees, PhD students and students in the field of Music Therapy and related fields – art therapy, dance movement therapy, physiotherapy, psychology, pedagogics, music theory and other fields. Participation in the

Forum will enable the exchange of scientific opinions and experiences among people representing the broadly defined field of music therapy.

We propose the following thematic areas:

- Wrocław Music Therapy history and tradition
- Polish music therapy centres
- current trends and scientific research in music therapy
- music therapy in rehumanisation of contemporary life
- COVID-19 pandemic – opportunities and restrictions for music therapy
- importance of music therapy in the therapy of people treated for COVID-19
- clinical practice of music therapy for adults
- music therapy of children with special educational needs
- biopsychosocial character of music therapy
- music therapy and related fields: art therapy, dance movement therapy, occupational therapy, rehabilitation, psychology, pedagogics, music theory and other fields.

It will be possible to participate in the 2nd European Forum of Music Therapists in a stationary form at the Karol Lipiński Academy of Music in Wrocław. We will make every effort to ensure fruitful participation of all participants, members of the Scientific Committee and Guests as well as mutual integration.

We plan active participation of foreign guests from various continents, including from the USA and Europe. The conference will be accompanied by, among others, concerts, exhibitions, workshops, presentations and performances of music bands.

We believe that the 2nd European Forum of Music Therapists will become an important all-Polish and international scientific panel on the exchange of knowledge and experience, and that it will also be an inspiration for taking up new research challenges and establishing co-operation.

- **10 October 2022** – paying the participation fee (passive participants) and sending payment confirmation
